**A PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
OF THE COUNTY OF TRINITY  
RECOGNIZING ORESTA EQUIBEL UPON HER RETIREMENT FROM THE TRINITY COUNTY  
PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM**

**WHEREAS**, after 16 years of service, Trinity County Librarian Oresta Esquibel will retire from the Trinity County Public Library System; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta's education in Russian and Slavic Studies and a Master of Library Services, and her 37 years of library service as a Law Librarian in Salt Lake City, Associate Librarian at Westminster College and Assistant Director at Park City Public Library brought much benefit to the rural Trinity County Public Library system; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta's experience led to many improvements over the years such as automating the Trinity County Library System, a task that could be tough to achieve within the confines of rural libraries and limited funding; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta continuously managed the collections in the three libraries to remove outdated materials and replace them with newer up-to-date resources; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta worked cooperatively with Board of Supervisors, County Administrative Officers, Friends of the Library and various organizations over the years to pursue grants and secure funding for new resources; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta partnered with other North State libraries to migrate Trinity County Library to a less expensive, yet fully functional, integrated library system in 2011 by utilizing available grant funding; and


**WHEREAS**, Oresta successfully reorganized library services, staff, programs and essential technical functions in 2004 and the following years to address the budget shortfall and maximize efficiency with fewer staff; and

**WHEREAS**, Oresta has maintained traditional programs such as story time and the summer reading program for children while adapting to the ever changing digital era where libraries are still essential in the process of giving citizens access to knowledge. In these digital times libraries are needed more than ever before; and

**WHEREAS**, according to author Kurt Vonnegut, "The death of a library, any library, suggests that a community has lost its soul." Thank you Oresta for helping our community keep its soul, even in some very tight budgetary times.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED** that the Trinity County Board of Supervisors both individually and collectively hereby recognizes the retirement of Oresta Esquibel from the Trinity County Public Library System.

## Big French Creek Slide Timeline of Events

- January 16, 2016: A series of rock slides occur during heavy rains. An emergency project is initiated to clean debris from roadway, monitor the slope, and provide traffic control through the end of the rainy season.
- February 24, 2016: After continued rock slides, a supplemental emergency project is approved to install cable anchored rock fall drapery over the slide area as weather permits.
- July, 11, 2016: After multiple attempts to collect the required geotechnical information are delayed due to continued falling debris, the needed drilling data is gathered and analyzed, and a solution is proposed. A “catchment” area at the bottom of the slope is to be excavated and a large wall constructed between the catchment area and the highway to catch debris. It is determined that the rock fall drapery would not be adequate and should no longer be pursued. A new emergency project is developed to design and construct this solution.
- August, 2016: After obtaining necessary project clearances to excavate catchment area and construct debris wall, work begins. Work is halted in early October due to early rains triggering additional rock slides. On December 9, 2016, during a heavy storm, a large slide closes the highway.
- Current Status: Caltrans has received approval to construct a temporary detour near the Trinity River. This detour is currently under construction, and is anticipated to be open to one way traffic by the second week of January, 2017. Once the detour is in place, the slide area will be accessed from above, and work will commence from the top to the bottom to remove approximately 200,000 cubic yards of material, provide a more stable slope, finalize construction of the catchment area and debris wall, and eventually reopen Highway 299 to normal traffic. A follow up project will likely be necessary to construct drainage settling basins, provide maintenance access, and perform other work to finalize the slide repair.
