- · More than 60% of students have experienced tooth decay by third grade.\*
- 1 in 5 kids have untreated tooth decay.\*
- Approximately 440,000 children missed at least one day of school due to a dental problem in 2018.\*\*

- Behavior issues and high emotion
- Infection/illness
- Poor nutrition
- Absences from childcare/school
