DEFINITION:

Under supervision, to perform law enforcement, crime prevention and crime detection activities; to guard and supervise inmates in County jail facilities; to act as bailiff; and do related work as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

Basic rules and regulations of the Sheriff's Department and jail operations procedures; Major provision of criminal and traffic law with particular reference to apprehension, arrest, search and seizure, and the rules of evidence; Basic laws applicable to the apprehension and treatment of juveniles; Care and operation of small firearms and other law enforcement equipment; First aid techniques.

Ability to:

Observe accurately and remember names, faces, numbers, incidents, and places; Secure information from witnesses and suspects; Make independent decisions while working in the field; Analyze situations accurately and adopt effective courses of action; Control, direct and instruct inmates individually and in large groups; Write clear and comprehensive reports; Understand and carry out oral and written directions and regulations and departmental policies; Use and care of firearms; Establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with fellow employees and the general public; Learn to operate surveillance, control and communications equipment; Think and act quickly in emergencies, judge situations and people accurately; Learn understand, and interpret laws and regulations; Some positions may require the ability to use small boats in the performance of their duties; Learn standard broadcasting procedures of a radio system; Meet standards of physical stature, endurance, and agility established by the County of Trinity.

Experience and Education:

One year performing duties similar to that of a Deputy Sheriff I within the County of Trinity. High school graduate or possession of a G.E.D. certificate. Graduation from a California Law Enforcement Academy and possession of a POST Basic Certificate.

License and Certificates -

Possession of an appropriate valid California Driver's License, graduation from a POST certified California Law Enforcement Academy with possession of a Basic POST certificate.

Special Requirements-

Minimum age at date of hire: 18, No felony convictions, U.S. Citizenship is required or application for citizenship must have been filed at least one year prior to recruitment date for the position
