***This RFA is being issued with the goal of placing grant awards into agreement by July 1, 2010 for FY 2010-2011.**

Grant awards are based on anticipated tax revenue and, as always, is contingent upon the availability of funds. Should State funds allocated for the FY2010/11 Prop.10 Tobacco Tax for Trinity County Children & Families Commission be less than anticipated, you will be notified and grant requests and awards may need to be modified.

In 1998 voters passed Proposition 10, adding a 50-cent tax to each pack of cigarettes sold to create First 5 California, also known as the California Children and Families Commission. These funds are managed and distributed at a local level by Trinity County Children and Families First Commission. First 5 Trinity is dedicated to improving the lives of California's young children ages 0-5 and their families through a comprehensive system of education, health services, childcare, and other crucial programs.

Grant applications must provide services or support in these four result areas and achieve measurable outcomes.

- Improved Family Functioning (Family Support, Education and Services)**
- Improved Child Development. (Child Development Services)**
- Improved Health (Health Education and Services)**
- Improved Systems of Care (Community Strengthening Efforts)**
