### Trinity County Mental Health Services Act (MHSA)

**Request to gain approval from the State Department of Mental Health to approve the MHSA Innovation Plan for fiscal year 2009/2010 based on information contained in Information Notice 09-02 generated by the State Department of Mental Health**

Pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code Section 5847(a.1), section 5848 (a,& b), section 5892 (a.3,& 4), and California Code of Regulations section 3315 each County receiving Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funding may request MHSA Innovation funds.

Each county must follow State Department of Mental Health Information Notice 09-02 and submit the appropriate plans in order to amend its existing MHSA Agreement with the State of California Department of Mental Health following the required Public Hearing.

***The Trinity County Behavioral Health Services Agency recommends that the Innovation Plans, totaling \$70,000.00 be requested from the State DMH and deposited into our County Behavioral Health Services Agency Account for use in Fiscal Year 09/10 for the purpose of implementing the project as outlined in the application which is also posted along side this public notice.***

In accordance with the California Code of Regulations, this Request is being posted for a 30-day public comment period prior to submission to the State DMH. The posting period will be from August 20, 2009 to September 23, 2009.
