


POSTRELEASE COMMUNITY SUPERVISON (PRCS) 3450 PC


- 144 PRCS packets have been received since October 2011

- 52 warrants have been issued (absconded); 5 warrants are currently active
- 93 PRCS revocations have been filed to date (on 48 offenders)







 3 PRCS Cases have been sentenced to Local Prison in Trinity County

- 21 PRCS Cases have been sentenced to Jail in Trinity County
- 10 PRCS Cases have been sentenced to State Prison again



COUNTY JAIL PRISON AND MANDATORY SUPERVISION (MS) 1170 PC

- 71 cases sentenced under the 1170(h) PC since the program began
- 23 cases were split sentenced under Mandatory Supervision (MS)
- 6 Mandatory Supervision cases are active
- 71 cases were sentenced to jail for a total of 1657 months/138.08 years for an average of 23.33 months per case
- 1 case was sentenced to 36 months Electronic Monitoring
- The supervision period for the 23 MS cases after jail was served was a total of 539.5 months/44.96 years for an average of 23.5 months supervision per offender
- 2 MS was sent to (CDCR) state prison for a new felony conviction
- 9 MS was revoked and sentenced to straight county jail
