- **1.01** Conducted a public hearing and took the following actions concerning Planning File P 13-02 regarding APN 024-39-70, in the Weaverville area:
  - 1. Adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration, finding that on the basis of the whole record before the Board, including the initial study and comments received, that there is no substantial evidence that the project will have a significant effect on the environment and that a mitigated Negative Declaration reflects the Board's independent judgment and analysis; and
  - Adopted Resolution No. 2013-61 amending the Weaverville Community Plan for the subject property from Commercial to Multi Family Residential and approve an agreement for compliance with rezoning conditions (Exhibit B); and
  - 3. Introduced, waived the reading of and enacted Ordinance No. 315-803 amending Trinity County Zoning Ordinance (Ordinance No. 315) amending the zoning of APN 024-39-70 from General Commercial (C-2) to Multi Family Residential (R-3). (Planning Commission recommendation was to approve the request.)
