Licensed Septic Pumpers who perform septic system inspections are obligated to do so with proper information, training, procedures, and in some communities a license is required. Some states, like California, have specific certification requirements for inspectors of septic systems, as well as specific regulations regarding the performance of the inspection itself.

<u>Watch Out:</u> Too often we hear from customers who claim they had their septic system "inspected" by a septic tank pumping company and all they did was pump the septic tank. Although licensed to pump septic tanks, they are not licensed to additionally inspect your septic system.

Following the pumping of your tank and a septic system inspection by a licensed septic system inspector, you will receive a certificate or report that indicates your septic system is functioning properly and the report should indicate the size and type of septic tank you have.

If your system is not functioning properly, you will not receive a certificate, but the report or receipt should indicate the issue you are having with your system and the suggested repair needed.

Emergency Water Haulers – Please verify potable water tank has not been used for anything but potable water from reliable water source. You can request to see their records.
