In order to permit the disposal of the remaining fire debris from properties affected by the Helena Fire, the information requested on this form needs to be provided to Trinity County Solid Waste by February 2, 2018. Debris approved for disposal will be accepted at the Junction City Transfer Station from January 22 through February 6 for the regular gate fees of \$17.84 per cubic yard. When providing volumes, use bag size and count or cubic yards. Loads must be sized to fit in the dumpster provided without occupying excessive air space. Household Hazardous Waste and prohibited waste will not be accepted. To determine volume measure **Length x Width x Height divided by 27**. Please include any vehicles that have been abated if disposal is needed. These will be accepted at the Junction City Transfer Station in a separate area for recycling by a certified recycler.
