DISPOSAL OF PERISHABLE FOOD ITEMS
AND
FOOD STORAGE APPLIANCES (REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS)
September 14, 2017

The Trinity County Solid Waste Department will continue to offer free disposal of perishable food items which were spoiled as a result of the Helena Fire evacuation at the Junction City Transfer Station during regular hours (Friday, Saturday, Monday and Tuesday - 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.) through September 19th.

PERISHABLE FOODS MUST BE SEPARATED FROM OTHER HOUSEHOLD WASTE.

HOUSEHOLD WASTE DISPOSAL WILL BE AT STANDARD RATES.

Additionally, refrigerators and/or freezers that are beyond use (spoiled food odor saturation, **not fire debris**) from the evacuated areas may be disposed free of charge at the Junction City Corp Yard (across from North Fork Grange on Dutch Creek Road) at the following times:

Friday	September 15	10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
Saturday	September 16	10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

ONLY APPLIANCES WITH THE DOORS REMOVED CAN BE DISPOSED.

APPLIANCES MUST BE COMPLETELY EMPTIED OF ALL CONTENT.

Participants must have a form of identification that identifies their household as one which is within the evacuated areas. This could be either a driver's license reflecting the evacuated address, or a utility bill showing service location along with a driver's license with the same name that is on the utility bill.
