The following question will be submitted to the qualified voters of the unincorporated area of Trinity County:

**MEASURE I**

To prevent cuts or elimination of local life-support ambulance service, including two 24/7 ambulances staffed for emergencies stationed in Weaverville and Hayfork, shall a measure imposing a \$45 per year special tax for each parcel developed with residential or commercial uses, until repealed by voters, providing \$258,000 annually, requiring all funds to be spent locally with Citizen Oversight, be adopted in accordance with the terms of the Trinity Life Support Community Services District Formation?
