

Voting in Trinity County for the June 07, 2022 Statewide Primary Election

Every active registered voter will receive and vote a Vote-By-Mail ballot. You should receive your ballot by May 16th. If you do not, please reach out to the office.

- In this election you will receive a two (2) card ballot, which is four (4) pages. All cards/pages must be submitted at the same time in the returned envelope provide.
- You do not have to vote on all contests. Those you do vote on will still count.
- All mailed ballots are counted, regardless if the contest is close.
- All signatures are compared to the signatures on file. If the signature doesn't match, you will be contacted and be given an opportunity to correct the issue.
- If you make a mistake, you can ask for a replacement ballot.
- You may return your ballot in one of 3 ways:
 - By USPS, no postage required.
 - Secure Ballot Drop Box
 - In person at the Trinity County Elections office, or at any Trinity County Polling Place.

Remember, always contact your local Elections department for accurate information about voting in your jurisdiction.
