June 7, 2022 Statewide Direct Primary Election

TWO CARD BALLOT

In this election every active registered voter will receive their two (2) card ballot, which is four (4) pages in the mail. All cards/pages must be submitted at the same time in the returned envelope provided. Once your return voted ballot is received, you cannot submit any additional pages. If by mistake, you do not return both cards, you will not be given the opportunity to return the card that was left out.

Make sure to return all ballot cards when returning your ballot!

THREE WAYS TO RETURN YOUR BALLOT

Secure Ballot Drop Box - Located throughout Trinity County, no later than 8 PM on Election Day. Please see the Display ad in this week's Trinity Journal or check the Trinity County Elections web page. Pictures of Official Secure Ballot Drop Boxes and their locations are listed. Your ballots are safe in the Trinity County Official Secure Ballot Drop Boxes.

Trinity County Polling Location - On Election Day no later than 8 PM

USPS - Must be postmarked on or before Election Day and received within seven (7) days.

DON'T FORGET TO SIGN YOUR RETURN ENVELOPE

Sign your return envelope next to the red X. The Trinity County Elections office will compare your signature on your return envelope to the signatures on file. If for any reason we cannot verify that signature you will be contacted to correct the issue.
