Application Packet:

This new application packet, until we can accept new applications, will be used solely for license transfers and will not be used for renewals. There will be a new renewal packet coming soon, but until then continue to use the renewal packet listed on the website.

License Transfers:

We are excited to announce that we will be, as of today 10/5/2022, accepting our new application/transfer packet for the transfer of issued licenses only (see Trinity County's website for the updated forms). The application packet will need to be completed by/for the recipient of the license transfer. The license transfer form will need to be signed by both parties and notarized. If you are an agent or the applicant, that will be submitting a transfer, we will schedule a review appointment with you to ensure that we have all the necessary documents and forms before we accept the application and transfer.
