The Cannabis Director will approve the above referenced CCL on December 28, 2022. Should you desire to appeal this decision, you must do so within 10-working days, or by January 9, 2022, pursuant to Trinity County Zoning Code Section 17.34.110.

Upon request, you may inspect the subject license application file at the County Planning Department in accordance with the Public Records Act.
