TRINITY COUNTY JUVENILE FACIITIES 2014/2016 BIENNIAL INSPECTION PURSUANT TO WELFARE AND INSTITUTIONS CODE SECTION 209.

On December 6, 2016, The Board of State and Community Corrections sent a letter notifying Trinity County Probation Department that corrective action was required to address Section 1355, Institutional Assessment and Plan, as we found the section to be non-compliant for the 2014-2016 inspection cycle. At the time of inspection, though there was current policy and procedure in place for Institutional Assessments and Case Plans, the facility provided no documentation to show that that the plans were completed specific to detained youth.

On April 25, 2017, correspondence was received from Trinity County Probation that provided updated documentation and proof of implementation of the Institutional Assessment and Plan. We have updated our records to note that the agency has corrected the issue. This concludes all work necessary for the 2014-2016 Inspection Cycle. Thank you for your timely response.
