Trinity County Coronavirus (COVID-19) Health Advisory

TRINITY COUNTY – Trinity County continues to experience widespread COVID-19 infections. With widespread illness, it can be challenging to identify all private and public sources of spread and inform our communities. Trinity County Public Health Branch (TCPHB) emphasizes our best strategy is universal adherence to prevention measures and mandates as specified by the California Department of Public Health (CDPH).

All residents in Trinity County and all Businesses in Trinity County must adhere to the mandates including universal face covering and social distancing found at:

The Regional Stay at Home Order is triggered when our Northern California Regional ICU bed capacity (available staffed beds) is 15% or less. This information is updated weekly. At this time (week of December 7, 2020) our Northern California Region ICU capacity is 25%.

CDPH statewide travel guidance and travel restrictions include the following:

- For those counties in regions not under the Regional Stay at Home Order:
 - Non-essential travel is strongly discouraged
 - Hotels and vacation rentals should not rent to persons coming from Counties that are under the Regional Stay at Home Order.
